

SBM2301 Supply Chain Management Fundamentals

Unit description

SBM2301 Supply Chain Management Fundamentals covers the fundamentals of supply chain management, and is a pre-requisite to SBM2302 Advanced Supply Chain Management. It delivers working knowledge and competencies in the techniques necessary to optimise supply chain processes on both upstream and downstream, in the design and delivery of an organisation's products and services.

This unit is an elective unit in the MBA program.

- [ULO1] Demonstrate an understanding of the strategic importance of procurement and supply networks in modern organisations.
- [ULO2] Demonstrate an understanding of supply chain networks and their contractual and legal obligations.

- [ULO4] Negotiate, develop and manage supplier contracts, and measure supply chain and suppliers' performance.
